Update to the VCS 2007.1: Rules on Incremental VCU Issuance

Background

The VCS normative document *Project Registration and VCU Issuance Process* sets out the rules on issuing VCUs incrementally from a verification report within the VCS registry system. VCUs can be issued incrementally from a verification report under the grandparenting process only (i.e., the verification report must be issued on or before 30 September 2009).

In order to provide continued flexibility with respect to the VCU issuance process, the VCS Association has taken the decision to allow incremental issuance from a verification report indefinitely.

VCS Program Update

The VCS Association hereby issues the following update with respect to incremental issuance of VCUs from a verification report:

- 1) VCUs can be issued incrementally from a verification report regardless of the date on which the verification report was issued.
- 2) All other rules with respect to incremental issuance set out in the VCS normative document *Project Registration and VCU Issuance Process* shall still apply.

Such change to the VCS rules is effective from 11 June 2010.
